On-demand natural gas **hot water heater-** \$300 rebate

Room Air Conditioner- Until Sept 30 turn-in program to trade room AC for EnergyStar model-

Central AC- rebate of \$300 for 14 SEER Energy Star, \$500 for 15 SEER Energy Star

Solar photovoltaic (electric)- rebates up to 50% of system cost (\$5/watt). No sales, property tax.

Financing- income-qualified solar electric lease program coming in August

Connecticut Housing Investment Fund (CHIF)

- Low-interest home improvement loans up to \$15,000 (income limited)
- 10 yr financing available for windows, doors, insulation, EnergyStar appliances, solar systems, replacement roof
