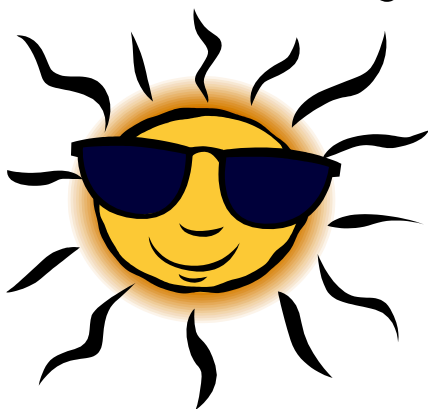

Tot Camp- 9:00 am -12:00 pm Tot Camp is for children ages 3 – 5, who have not yet attended Kindergarten. The campers will participate in activities such as: arts and crafts, gym games, sport games, story time and playground activities. Special events are planned throughout the summer. Campers will have snack every day. ***Full day option available.***

Youth Camp- (May sign up daily) 9:00 am -12:00 pm Youth Camp is for children who have completed K – 6th grade. We are offering an AM session, a PM session, and a full day. You will participate in activities such as: arts and crafts, gym games, sport games, classic games, and hiking. Special events like inflatable water slides, theater show, Zoo Station. Weather permitting, we go to Vet’s Park every Thursday morning, so bring your bathing suit.

Specialty Camps - 12:15 pm -3:00 pm The afternoon groups will participate in specialty sessions where the children will have an opportunity to learn and/or improve in a particular area. For each session, the child needs to select one activity for the week. Sign up early because most specialties have enrollment caps, some of the more popular camps usually fill up fast. **Youth Camp must be chosen if camper isn’t attending the whole week.**

Youth Camp: A PM extension of the morning session, participate in activities such as: gym games, sports, arts & crafts, movies, hiking, and more!

Field Games: Play many of your favorite games like Capture the Flag, Kickball, Jackpot, Wiffleball and football.

All Sports: Volleyball, Basketball, Soccer, even Table Tennis! Let’s learn the basics, and have some fun with a variety of our favorite sports.

Tennis: Marcy’s Tennis Academy will be on hand to instruct the fundamentals of the forehand, backhand, volley, serve, and overhead smash while playing fun-filled games and drills. Players should bring their own junior tennis racket, **Additional fee of \$20.**

Drama Camp: Calling all actors and actor wannabees! Join us each week for games of improvisation and pantomime. Use costume accessories and props to create unique characters while acting in skits. Learn the difference between acting on stage and acting for film. Get in touch with your creative side!

Film Camp; Lights, Camera, ACTION! Create your own story, write a script, build your own props, and learn how to shoot your own short-film!

Vet’s Park: Discover and explore all that the outdoors has to offer! Swimming, frogs, playground, nature walks & more! **Bring extra \$\$ for the Snack Bar!**

Mad Scientists: We’ll be making exciting and educational homemade science experiments, not just your classic volcanoes. **Additional fee of \$20.**

Bowling: We’ll be heading down to Amity Bowl for some fun at the lanes! **Space will be very limited, so register early. Additional fee of \$25.**

Karate: We are partnering with Pereira’s Academy of Karate to offer our campers karate lessons! We will provide transportation to the Academy, located at 696 Amity Rd. in Bethany. Ed Pereira has personally trained for over 28 years, and holds 3 black belts in different arts. His highest rank is a 6th degree black belt in Tang Soo Do (the art he will teach during this program). Ed will be the instructor for this Specialty Camp. Campers must enroll for the entire week. ***No Daily Option*** We also run this as an after-school program, so keep an eye out for that flyer! **Space will be very limited, so register early. Additional fee of \$25.**

Dance Attitude: Dance Attitude will be opening their studio to give our campers a chance to learn the art of dance. This Specialty Camp will consist of all the fundamentals to succeed as a dancer: *Self-Discipline - Control- Stretching -Choreography - Musicality.* Dance Attitude has been in business for 23 years. We will provide transportation to the Academy, located at 696 Amity Rd. in the Bethany Plaza. Campers must enroll for the entire week. ***No Daily Option*** We also run this as an after-school program, so keep an eye out for that flyer! **Space will be very limited, so register early. Additional fee of \$25.**

- All campers should come to camp wearing sneakers, and appropriate clothing.
 - Bring a change of clothes every day, just in case we get wet; it gets hot in the summer!
 - Campers should bring a labeled water bottle, and snack; Full day campers should bring a labeled lunch.
