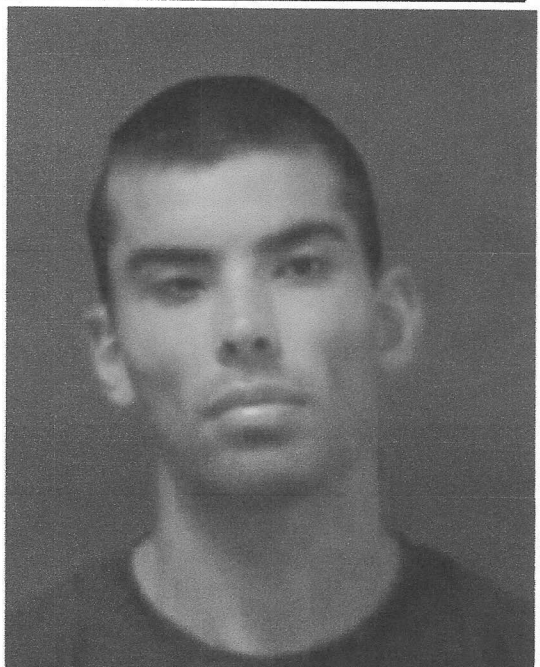

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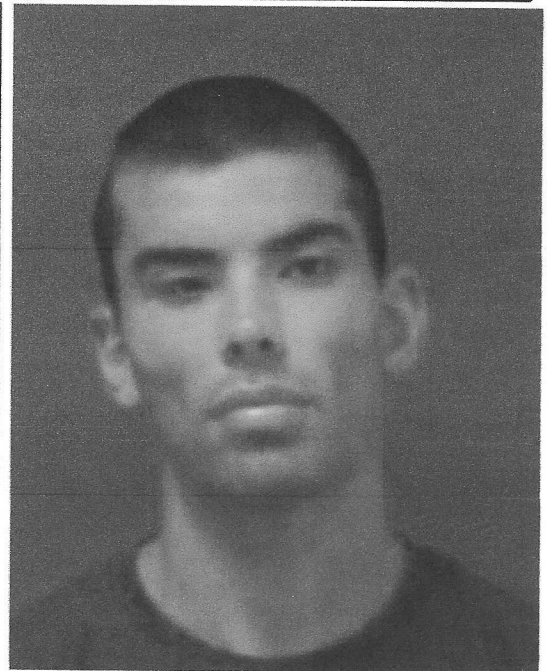

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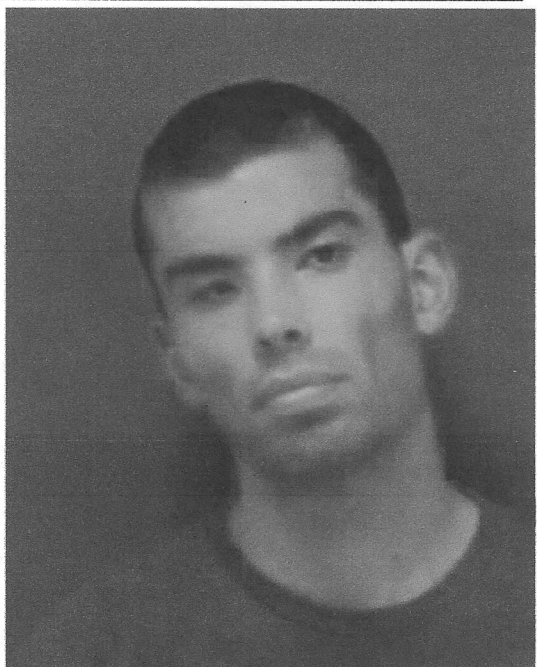

The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That the Affiant, Trooper Ewerton Gouveia, #1196, being duly sworn does depose and state that he is a member of the Connecticut State Police and has been since July 5, 2019. This Affiant is currently assigned to Troop I - Bethany Barracks, under the command of Lieutenant Josue Dorelus #043, and at all pertinent times mentioned herein was acting in his official capacity as such member of said department. The following facts and circumstances are stated from personal knowledge and observations as well as information received from fellow officers acting in their official capacity and from official reports.
2. That, the information contained in this affidavit pertains to multiple accusations of sexual assault and risk of injury to juveniles, involving an adult male offender and juvenile female victims. The names and identifying information of the victims will not be disclosed in the affidavit in compliance with the confidentiality requirements of sections 54-86d and 54-86e of the Connecticut General Statutes. The juvenile female victims will be referred to hereinafter as Victim #1, Victim #2, Victim #3 and Victim #4.
3. That on 12/22/2022, this Affiant was assigned to Patrol 2 on the evening shift. The Duty Supervisor was Sgt. Portorreal #286. This Affiant was operating my assigned State Police cruiser which was equipped with a Panasonic Arbitrator Mobil Video Recorder (MVR). This Affiant was also wearing the assigned Panasonic Body Worn Camera (BWC).
4. That at approximately 1837 hours, this Affiant was instructed by Troop I - Bethany desk personnel to report to [REDACTED] in Bethany for a reported of a sexual assault.
5. That on 12/22/22, Troop I received a fax from DCF about a [REDACTED] Victim #1, who reported that she was touched by an intern at the after school program, located at the Bethany Parks and Recreation. The intern was later identified as Anthony Mastrangelo (DOB 07/01/99). Bethany Parks and recreation is located at 40 Peck Rd in Bethany. As a result, DCF case worker, [REDACTED], was

contacted. [REDACTED] stated that she was contacted by the Bethany School System, and that the parents of Victim #1 were the ones to file the complaint.

6. That, during Victim#1's investigation, three other victims were brought up. It should be noted that an Arrest Warrant for Victim #1's case was already approved and served to the defendant.

7. That on 2/3/23, this Affiant contacted Victim #2's mother, [REDACTED], in order to notify her of a pending investigation and to request a face to face meeting in order to update her on the progress of the investigation. At the time of the face to face meeting, this Affiant explained to [REDACTED] that there was an ongoing investigation at Parks and Rec in Bethany, CT and advised her that this Affiant was unable to give a tremendous amount of detail at the time but requested [REDACTED] to have a conversation with her daughter, (Victim #2 [REDACTED]), to determine if anything unusual had been going on at school or at the after school program at Parks and Rec. [REDACTED] verbalized understanding and agreed to contact me with pertinent details after the above mentioned conversation with her child (Victim #2) had taken place.

8. That on 2/8/23, at approximately 1600 hours, this Affiant met with Victim #2's mother, [REDACTED] at Troop I's lobby and obtained the following written, sworn statement; "Around 2/3/23, I, [REDACTED] received a call from Tpr Gouveia stating there was an investigation that I may have some information about. I then went to Troop I and met with Tpr Gouveia. Tpr Gouveia then informed me of an active investigation at the Parks and Rec, the after school program where my daughter (Victim #2) goes to. When I asked Tpr Gouveia what the investigation was about, Tpr Gouveia explained that he was unable to give me details as it was an active investigation and requested me to approach my daughter and ask her if she has observed any unusual activities or if she knows of anything that is going on at the Parks and Rec. On 02/04/23, I spoke with my daughter and asked her if something had been going on at Parks and Rec. My daughter then stated that there was something going on with her friends, Victims #1, #3 and #4. My daughter stated that Anthony, one of the Parks and Rec counselors, would touch them and make them feel uncomfortable. My daughter stated that he did it to lots of kids. My daughter then stated that the girls talked about it together and told someone (unknown). My daughter then stated that Anthony won't be able to work with children any more. When I asked my daughter if she was touched and where he touched her, she got upset and wouldn't say what happened but that it had been happening since December. My daughter stated that she didn't remember if it happened when she was in 3rd grade also."

9. That it should be noted that on 4/2/23 when this Affiant met with [REDACTED] stated the following: "In December of 2022, my daughter started having outbursts at home, saying she didn't want to go to Parks and Rec anymore and that she wished I was a stay at home mom. My daughter would say things like, "you don't love me." My daughter was very emotional. My daughter also refused her yearly

examination at her doctors in March of 2023, where they check [REDACTED]"

10. That on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at approximately 1430 hours, Victim #2 completed a Forensic Interview with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is a lead Forensic Interviewer at [REDACTED]. The interview took place at [REDACTED].

11. That this interview is regarding an accusation of sexual assault that took place between Victim #2 and her counselor, Anthony Mastrangelo (DOB: 07/01/1999).

12. That the interview was video/audio recorded and a copy of the CD was submitted as evidence with this report.

13. That the forensic interview is summarized as follows:
 At the start of the interview, the social worker spends some time establishing a rapport with the victim. She does so by asking the victim to tell her some things about herself. After about 5 minutes, she begins her line of questioning. Victim #2 explains that she lives in Bethany, CT with [REDACTED]. When asked why she is there, she reports there was an incident at school that involved her and her friends that they had questions about. She explains that there was a counselor at school that was having the girls sit on his lap and put his hands down their pants [REDACTED]. She identified the counselor as Anthony and recalls that the incident happened at Parks and Rec in Bethany, CT. When asked to discuss the incident, at first, Victim #2 is resistant and doesn't want to talk about it. With some encouragement, she explains further that she has seen Anthony touching her friend, Victim #1's [REDACTED] with his hand, underneath her clothing. She states that Victim #1 was seated on his lap. She explains that this happened to her as well, more than once. She recalls one incident where she was playing hide and seek at Parks and Rec. Anthony asked her to come sit on his lap but she refused because she was playing. Eventually, after the game was over, she agreed to sit on his lap because he had asked her to do so. During the time she was on his lap, she reports that he put his hand down the back of her pants, [REDACTED]. She demonstrates on an anatomical chart where he was touching her which corresponds with the [REDACTED]. She used to go to the bathroom as an excuse to get off his lap and end the contact. She recalls that this type of incident happened to her at least 3-4 times. She can't recall exactly when the touching began but she believes the hide and seek game took place in January of 2023. She goes on to explain that she's been going to Parks and Rec for about 1.5 years and that Anthony has been a counselor there the entire time. She asks the social worker how it could be possible that no other counselors saw this happening, because she remembers another counselor that witnessed it, named [REDACTED]. She goes on to describe another incident at Parks and Rec where she was going to watch TV on the couch. She reports that Anthony picked her up around the waist and put her on his lap and put

his hand down her pants and [redacted]. Finally, she remembers after going back to school for 4th grade. The touching started again about 4 days into being back to school. She discussed it with her close friends and they decided to tell a grown up about it. She denies any touching besides on her [redacted]. She also denies that he ever talked during the touching or asked her to touch him or asked her to keep the touching a secret. The interview concludes with her denying any concern with her body and with her stating that she feels safe at home but sometimes worries when she's in the shower that someone will come in through the window to hurt her. She denies having social media and denies ever being shown any inappropriate photos by anyone at any time and denies anyone ever taking photos [redacted]. She knows who to tell if anything like this were to ever happen again.

14. That on Friday, May 12th, 2023, at approximately 1700 hours, this Affiant went to Parks & Rec, located at 40 Peck Rd in Bethany, in order to interview a few employees.

15. That this interview is regarding an accusation of sexual assault that took place between a few children and their counselor, Anthony Mastrangelo (DOB: 07/01/1999).

16. That the interviews were video/audio recorded on my body worn camera (BWC).

17. That this Affiant met with counselor, [redacted] interview is summarized as follows:

She reports that she has been coming here since she was 8 but working/paid for a few years. She can't recall a handbook that she had to sign but reports that there's a beginning of the year meeting where the rules are reviewed and then a weekly staff meeting most weeks to discuss updates. She is not sure if there's a specific policy about touching but she doesn't usually do that and if she does she always asks for permission before she touches the kids. She knows Mastrangelo and would describe him as a friend. She has seen Mastrangelo with the kids, "sometimes too much, piggy back rides, things like that." It's not personally what she would do, but she admits that everyone's style is different. She reports that she has seen hugs and lap sitting between Mastrangelo and the kids, but no kissing observed.

18. That after speaking with [redacted] this Affiant met with counselor, [redacted] interview is summarized as follows:

He reports that he has been working there for 2 years paid, but was a CIT there prior and a camper there since he was little. He knows Mastrangelo and has known him since he was a kid. He describes Mastrangelo as a "great guy, nice as can be," and reports that he's never heard any complaints about Mastrangelo. He can't recall but thinks he may have signed some type of handbook/document when he was hired. From what he recalls, hugging is OK but kissing is not allowed. Personally, he doesn't like to

be touched. He has observed lap sitting, has seen piggy back rides with other staff members (both male and female). He has seen Anthony with campers on his lap, but describes it as more on his knee than lap and nothing inappropriate going on. He has seen it here and there, not a daily occurrence.





thinks she was asked to come in today for questions because her friend, Victim #1, told her parents about an after school counselor touching her inappropriately. Her parents then told the school and told her parents as well. She also states the police were notified and now the counselor doesn't work there anymore. She reports that she was touched inappropriately by a counselor at her after school program at Parks and Rec [REDACTED]. She identifies the counselor as Anthony Mastrangelo. The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That the Affiant, Trooper Ewerton Gouveia, #1196, being duly sworn does depose and state that he is a member of the Connecticut State Police and has been since July 5, 2019. This Affiant is currently assigned to Troop I - Bethany Barracks, under the command of Lieutenant Josue Dorelus #043, and at all pertinent times mentioned herein was acting in his official capacity as such member of said department. The following facts and circumstances are stated from personal knowledge and observations as well as information received from fellow officers acting in their official capacity and from official reports.
2. That, the information contained in this affidavit pertains to multiple accusations of sexual assault and risk of injury to juveniles, involving an adult male offender and juvenile female victims. The names and identifying information of the victims will not be disclosed in the affidavit in compliance with the confidentiality requirements of sections 54-86d and 54-86e of the Connecticut General Statutes. The juvenile female victims will be referred to hereinafter as Victim #1, Victim #2, Victim #3 and Victim #4.
3. That on 12/22/2022, this Affiant was assigned to Patrol 2 on the evening shift. The Duty Supervisor was Sgt. Portorreal #286. This Affiant was operating my assigned State Police cruiser which was equipped with a Panasonic Arbitrator Mobil Video Recorder (MVR). This Affiant was also wearing the assigned Panasonic Body Worn Camera (BWC).
4. That at approximately 1837 hours, this Affiant was instructed by Troop I - Bethany desk personnel to report to [redacted] in Bethany for a reported of a sexual assault.
5. That on 12/22/22, Troop I received a fax from DCF about a nine-year-old Victim #1, who reported that she was touched by an intern at the after school program, located at the Bethany Parks and Recreation. The intern was later identified as Anthony Mastrangelo (DOB 07/01/99). Bethany Parks and recreation is located at 40 Peck Rd in Bethany. As a result, DCF case worker [redacted] was

contacted. [redacted] stated that she was contacted by the Bethany School System, and that the parents of Victim #1 were the ones to file the complaint.

6. That, during Victim #1's investigation, three other victims were brought up. It should be noted that an Arrest Warrant for Victim #1's case was already approved and served to the defendant.

7. That on 03/01/23, this Affiant was instructed to contact [redacted] was reporting that his daughter (Victim #4) was a victim of an inappropriate touching that occurred during the after school program and at the summer camp at the Parks & Rec in Bethany CT.

8. That on 03/04/23, at approximately 1500 hours, this affiant met with [redacted] at [redacted] residence, located in [redacted]. This Affiant then obtained the following written, sworn statement from [redacted] "I am writing this statement to inform the proper authorities about a disturbing situation with my daughter, Victim #4, has made myself and my wife [redacted] aware of. When we lived in Bethany, CT. My daughter attended the summer camp program through the local parks and rec and also attended Bethany Community School. She would also go to the after school program at Parks and Rec. She had many friends and enjoyed her time living in the area. We moved to [redacted] and she now attends the local school system here. She is doing really well and has once again made many friends. She has remained in contact with some of her closer friends from Bethany and plans to continue those relationships. On Tuesday night February 28/2023, my daughter told me that during her time at the Bethany Park and Rec summer program and the after school program (2021 & 2022) she was touched by a man named Anthony in very inappropriate ways, more than once. She informed me that she was not the only young girl making this claim and the others were beginning to talk about this with their parents and the police. This man Anthony was a counselor at the park and rec summer program and the after school program the entire time my daughter was there. In our discussions about this situation, my daughter told me that while swimming in the lake at Veterans Memorial Park this man Anthony would put his hand down the back of her pants. She stated that he would attempt to help her swim and then begin to touch her in a way that made her very uncomfortable. More than once she told him "that's weird" and would quickly swim away. At this point she has not given me more detail than this and I have not pushed. My wife and my mother are both talking to her on a regular basis to make sure she understands how wrong this was and that she can speak about it safely. This situation at the lake happened multiple times. My daughter also stated that he would touch her inappropriately while at the park and rec after school building. She would finish school and report to the program on Peck Rd [redacted] each day. Many times, I would greet Anthony to pick up my daughter and witness him with young girls sitting on his lap. He would have her and other girls do this and she stated "he would again put his hand in her pants while sitting on his knees". This happened more than once. I absolutely believe my daughter's statement. Her story, the times, the people and situation have been

consistent in each telling. My question is why a grown man was being allowed to have little girls sit on his lap that are not his child. I want this man charged and punished for betraying her trust and the trust of the families in town."

10. That on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at approximately [REDACTED] Victim #4 completed a Forensic Interview with [REDACTED] Forensic Interviewer at the [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. The interview took place at [REDACTED].

11. That this interview is regarding an accusation of sexual assault that took place between Victim #4 and her counselor, Anthony Mastrangelo (DOB: 07/01/1999).

12. That the interview was video/audio recorded and a copy of the CD was submitted as evidence with this report.

13. That the forensic interview is summarized as follows:
The social worker begins the interview by introducing herself, members of the investigative team and where the interview is taking place. She spends about 5-10 minutes establishing a rapport with the victim, and introducing her to the interview room. Victim#4 tells the social worker some things about herself, walks her through a typical [REDACTED] school day for her and becomes more comfortable.

The social worker begins the line of questioning by asking about Victim #4's home life. She reports that she lives at home with her mom, dad, [REDACTED]. She tells the social worker that she knows she is there to discuss an incident that happened at school with a counselor named Anthony who works at her after school care (Parks and Rec in Bethany, CT). She doesn't know Anthony's last name. She reports that he has been putting his hand down her pants and touching her at Parks and Rec (both inside the building and outside the building). She also reports that he touched her inside her bathing suit while swimming in the lake during the Parks and Rec Summer camp at Bethany Memorial Park in Bethany, CT. The touching during Parks and Rec occurred while she was sitting on his lap. She also reports that he did the same thing to some of her friends (Victims #1, #2 and #3). The first incident that she recalls where he touched her took place around the swings, outside at the Bethany Memorial Park. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] It made her uncomfortable.

times at summer camp, she was sitting on a bench in the park area on his lap. The bench was near the swings. She draws a picture of what the area looked like for the social worker. She describes Anthony as having a weird face, short hair and thinks he is blind in one eye. She also recalls that in some cases, there were people around when it happened and other times there was no one who would have seen. She thinks that in 1st and second grade, the touching was down the back of her pants and was only her butt. In 3rd grade, in the water, he touched her front. She reports that the touching only stopped because she moved away and stopped attending Parks and Rec.

She denies Anthony ever asking her not to tell anyone about the touching. She denies Anthony ever asking her to touch him. She also reports she never actually witnessed Anthony touching any of her friends but they told her he had (Victims#1, #2 and #3).

She has no major concerns about her body and reports that she feels safe at home. She knows who to tell if anything like this were to happen again (she'd tell her dad).

14. That on Friday, May 12th, 2023, at approximately 1700 hours, this Affiant went to Parks & Rec, located at 40 Peck Rd in Bethany, in order to interview a few employees.

15. That this interview is regarding an accusation of sexual assault that took place between a few children and their counselor, Anthony Mastrangelo (DOB: 07/01/1999).

16. That the interviews were video/audio recorded on my body worn camera (BWC).

17. That this Affiant met with [REDACTED] interview is summarized as follows:

She reports that she has been coming here since [REDACTED] but working/paid for a few years. She can't recall a handbook that she had to sign but reports that there's a beginning of the year meeting where the rules are reviewed and then a weekly staff meeting most weeks to discuss updates. She is not sure if there's a specific policy about touching but she doesn't usually do that and if she does she always asks for permission before she touches the kids. She knows Mastrangelo and would describe him as a friend. She has seen Mastrangelo with the kids, "sometimes too much, piggy back rides, things like that." It's not personally what she would do, but she admits that everyone's style is different. She reports that she has seen hugs and lap sitting between Mastrangelo and the kids, but no kissing observed.

18. That after speaking with [REDACTED] this Affiant met with counselor [REDACTED] interview is summarized as follows:

He reports that he has been working there for 2 years paid, but was a CIT there prior and a camper there since he was little. He knows Mastrangelo and has known him since he was a kid. He describes Mastrangelo as a "great guy, nice as can be," and reports that he's never heard any complaints about Mastrangelo. He can't recall but thinks he may have signed some type of handbook/document when he was hired. From what he recalls, hugging is OK but kissing is not allowed. Personally, he doesn't like to be touched. He has observed lap sitting, has seen piggy back rides with other staff members (both male and female). He has seen Anthony with campers on his lap, but describes it as more on his knee than lap and nothing inappropriate going on. He has seen it here and there, not a daily occurrence.

19. That after speaking with [REDACTED] this Affiant met with counselor [REDACTED] interview is summarized as follows:

He has been working at Parks & Rec for "many years". He reports that there is a handbook that requires a signature when you are hired. When asked about the policy on counselors touching the kids, he clarifies that obviously, sometimes, the younger kids want to hold hands and whatnot, but in general, they try to discourage touching and interacting physically with the kids. He cites the "one person, one seat" policy. He reports that he knows Mastrangelo and describes him as "an amazing guy." He never heard a complaint about Mastrangelo. That Mastrangelo is working on his master's degree in teaching and [REDACTED] He denies ever having witnessed any inappropriate touching of the children by Mastrangelo or any other counselors.

20. That, during this investigation, this Affiant received an e-mail from [REDACTED] a Paralegal from [REDACTED] Attorneys at Law, stating that their office had been retained to assist Anthony Mastrangelo. This Affiant then spoke to [REDACTED] Mastrangelo's Attorney, via telephone. [REDACTED] requested an update on the case and informed this Affiant that he advises all of his clients not to speak with the police. [REDACTED] then advised this Affiant that Mastrangelo would not be giving a statement and advised that if additional information was needed from Mastrangelo, law enforcement should contact his office first.

21. That, this Affiant will be submitting separate arrest warrants for Victims #2 and #3.

22. That, this Affiant had a previous encounter with the defendant in [REDACTED] during a residential alarm call at [REDACTED] in Bethany, CT.
