ARTICLE I Permit [Adopted 11-20-1950 STM]

§ 170-1. Permit certifying system adequacy required. [Amended 12-7-1992 STM]

No human habitation shall hereafter be constructed in the Town of Bethany unless the Town Sanitarian Health Department, as designated by the Town, has issued a permit certifying that the sewage disposal facilities are within the standards established by regulation by the State Department of Public Health or are approved by the Town Sanitarian Health Department where such regulations provide for such approval.

§ 170-2. Fees. [Added 5-7-1951 ATM; 9-28-2000 STM]

The Town Sanitarian Health Department shall collect fees as part of applications for permits-as called for in § 170-4 and shall remit the same to the Town Treasurer.

§ 170-3. Penalties for offenses.

Any violation of this a Article shall may render the violator subject to a fine as determined by the Health Department of not more than \$25, and each day during which such violation exists shall be a separate offense.

ARTICLE II Sanitary Permit Fees [Adopted by the Board of Selectmen 11-24-1980]

§ 170-4. Fees enumerated. [Amended 9-28-2000 STM]

Sanitary permit fees shall be as follows:

- A. New septic system (one percolation test included): \$100.
- B. Percolation permit only: \$50 each.
- C. Repair permit: \$50.
- D. Well permit: \$40.

§ 170-5. Effective date.

The schedule will be effective January 1, 1981.
